Colorado Credit Union was recently honored with a Category's Best and a Diamond Award for its Financial Education efforts. The award was presented at the annual CUNA Marketing & Business Development Council Conference.

CCU's "Credit Bootcamp" received the highest honor in the Financial Education category. The Credit Bootcamp program ran in 2021 with the goal of helping young adults gain a better understanding of the core principals of financial literacy including budgeting, saving, managing debt, credit basics and mortgages. More than 130 participants completed the entire program.
